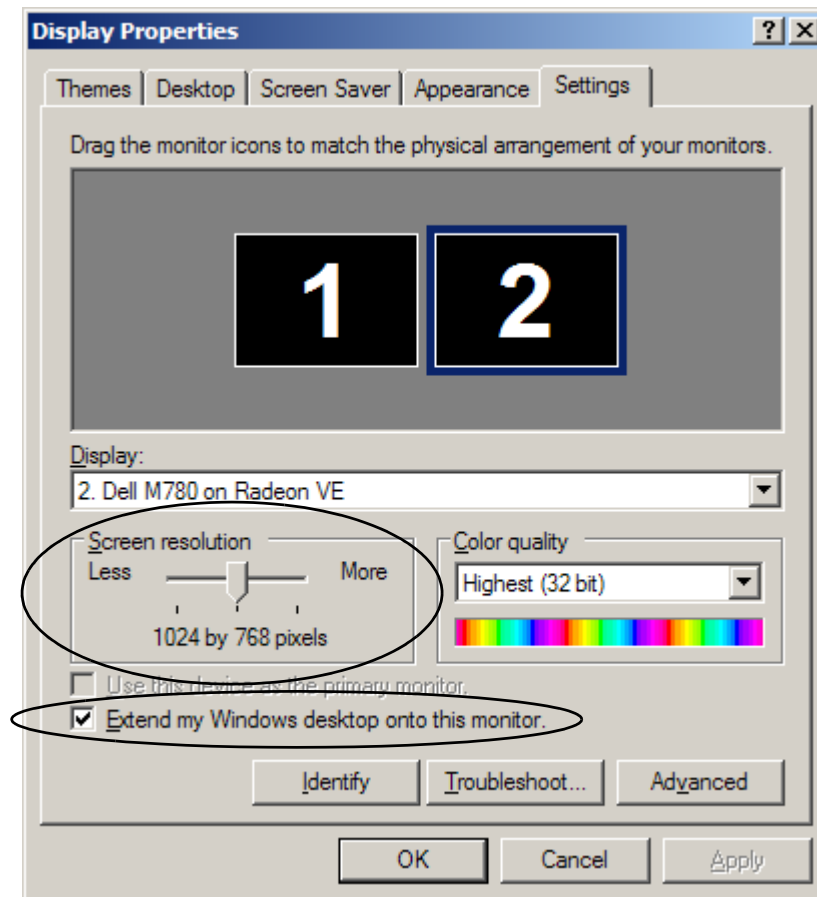


ETC® Service Note

Emphasis™ 3D v1.4.1 Default Display Settings



Due to an error in the disk image, the default state of a newly installed Emphasis 3D v1.4.1 system has the second display disabled. This can be fixed by enabling the second display in the Display Properties dialog box, pictured below. If you reinstall software using the recovery disks provided with your system, you will need to perform this procedure again to enable the second display.



Enable the second display:

- Step 1: Start up your Emphasis system and turn on both monitors. Allow the system to boot up completely.
- Step 2: Minimize Emphasis Visualization.
- Step 3: Right-click the desktop in the primary display and click **Properties**. The Display Properties dialog box will open.
- Step 4: Click the **Settings** tab.
- Step 5: Click the icon for monitor #2.
- Step 6: Click the box next to "Extend my Windows desktop onto this monitor."
- Step 7: Verify that the Screen resolution setting is appropriate for your monitor.
- Step 8: Click **OK**.
- Step 9: Maximize Emphasis Visualization.
